


Abraham & Lot. Genesis 12:1-9 & Genesis 13



Father Abraham's Song

To solve the problem Abram told Lot to choose an area for himself and that he (Abram) would take what was left. Memory Verse: Genesis 12:2 “I will make you into a great nation, and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing”.


Activities:

5. Did Lot make the best choice?




After learning about the story of Abram and Lot, which of the pictures below do you think belong?

Pick the pictures that belong.



