We use the present continuous to talk about things that are happening now. We make the present continuous with a form of **be** and the base form of the verb with **ing** added.


Short form

you're
he's / she's / it's
we're
you're
they're

Long form

I am
you are
he is /she is / it is
we are
you are
they are
