It begins with Jonathan Harker, a young English lawyer, as he travels to Transylvania. Harker plans to meet with Count Dracula, a client of his firm, in order to finalize a property transaction. When he arrives in Transylvania, the locals react with terror. The terrifying howling of wolves rings through the air as he arrives at the castle. When Harker meets Dracula, he notices that the man is old, pale and strange. Harker becomes further concerned when, after Harker cuts himself while shaving, Dracula makes a strange sound and takes him by his throat with both hands. Luckily, Dracula touches Jonathans golden cross making The Count to stop suddenly. Soon after, Harker is seduced by three female vampires, from whom he barely escapes. He then learns Dracula's secret—that he is a

vampire and survives by drinking human blood. Harker correctly assumes that he is to be the count's next victim. He attacks the count, but his efforts are unsuccessful. Dracula leaves Harker trapped in the castle and then, along with 50 boxes of dirt, departs for England.

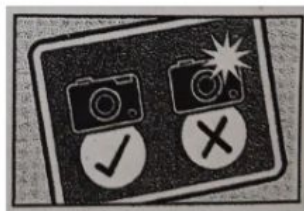
