






## The Pronouns She and He

Pronoun is a word that takes the place of a noun. The pronoun she replaces female nouns. Instead of saying Mary, you can use the pronoun SHE.



The pronoun **He** replaces **male** nouns. Instead of saying Robert, you can use the pronoun HE

He flies the kite






The Pronoun **you** is a word that takes the place of a noun that represent a single **person** or a group of **people** in front of you.




