

### Going to (for future plans)

We use **going to + verb** to talk about future plans and firm intentions. We also use **going to** to talk about predictions based on strong evidence.

*They are going to meet again next month. (plan)*  
*I'm going to be a lawyer. (firm intention)*  
*Look at the sky! It's going to rain. (prediction)*

*I'm not going to stay at home. I'll go camping too.*  
*Alicia isn't going to do any risky sports.*  
*Alicia and Michael [3] \_\_\_\_\_ stay in the motor home all the time.*


