

SIMPLE PAST OF REGULAR VERBS

Most **verbs** in English are **regular verbs**. **Regular verbs** are those whose past tense and past participles are formed by adding a -d, -ed or an -ied to the end of the **verb**.

Spelling rules

1- Regular verbs ending in -e, add d only:

like – liked arrive – arrived

2- Regular verb with one syllable, with a single vowel and ending in a single consonant, double the the final consonant and ed:

stop – stopped rob – robbed

3- Regular verbs ending in a consonant + y, change the -y into i and add ed:

study - studied cry - cried

4- However regular verbs ending in a vowel + -y, add ed:

play - played stay - stayed
