EVERYBODY WAS AFRAID. WILLY HAD TWO GUNS.



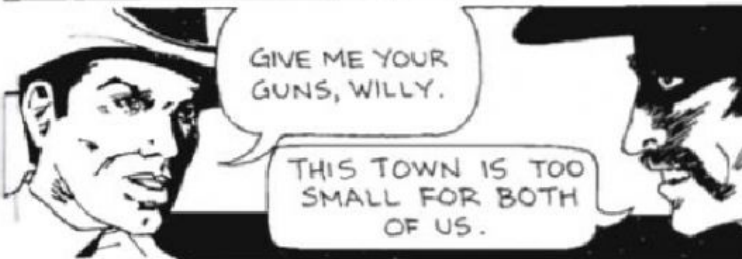
THE SHERIFF WAS IN HIS OFFICE. HE WAS ASLEEP.

## SIMPLE PAST OF REGULAR VERBS

Most **verbs** in English are **regular verbs**. **Regular verbs** are those whose past tense and past participles are formed by adding a **-d**, **-ed** or an **-ied** to the end of the **verb**.

arrive	arrived
fire	fired
move	moved
walk	walked
look	looked
rush	rushed
kill	killed
shout	shouted
wait	waited
pull	pulled
hurry	hurried
reply	replied
carry	carried

### Spelling rules

1- Regular verbs ending in **-e**, add **d** only:

like – liked

arrive – arrived

2- Regular verb with one syllable, with a single vowel and ending in a single consonant, double the the final consonant and ed:

stop – stopped

rob – robbed

3- Regular verbs ending in a consonant + **y**, change the **-y** into **i** and add **ed**:

study – studied

cry – cried

4- However regular verbs ending in a vowel + **-y**, add **ed**:

play – played

stay - stayed
