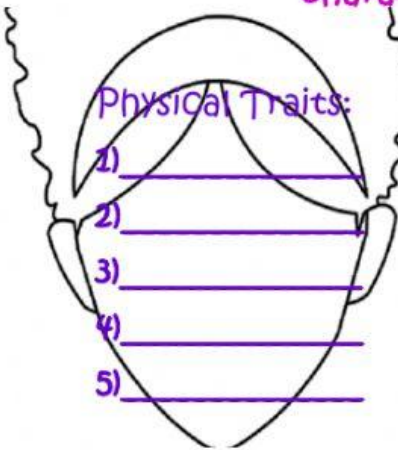

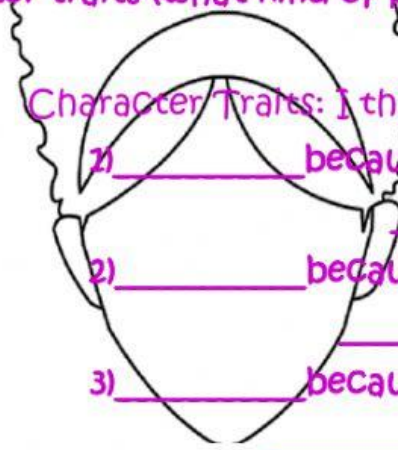
Describe Goldie. Tell her **physical traits** (what she looks like) and her
