- >> **be keen on doing** something
- >> **tell** somebody **to do** something

WORD PATTERNS

Core words	Example sentence
be interested in	Are you <u>interested in going</u> to the science museum?
be keen on	I'm not very <u>keen on playing</u> team games.
be ready for	Are you <u>ready for</u> the geography test?
have time to (do sth)	I didn't <u>have enough time to</u> revise last night.
look forward to (doing sth)	I'm really <u>looking forward to seeing</u> you next week!
make (sb) do	Never let someone <u>make you do something</u> you don't want to do.
prevent (sb) from (doing sth)	The security guards <u>prevented everyone from entering</u> the building.
spend time (doing sth)	Do you <u>spend a lot of time playing</u> video games?
