WHAT?	WHERE?
Utilizamos "What" al comienzo de algunas preguntas. Esta palabra puede ser traducida como "Qué".	Utilizamos "Where" al comienzo de algunas preguntas. Esta palabra puede ser traducida como "dónde".
Por ejemplo: WHAT do you do? (¿QUÉ es lo que haces?) – en relación al trabajo.	Por ejemplo: WHERE do you work? (¿DÓNDE trabajas?)
Una respuesta correcta sería, por ejemplo: What do you do? I am a doctor . (¿Qué es lo que haces? Yo soy un doctor .)	Una respuesta correcta sería, por ejemplo: Where do you work? I work at a hospital . (¿Dónde trabajas? Yo trabajo en un hospital .)
