## **Superlatives**

We use them to compare animals, people and things

- Adjectives of one or two syllables: Add -er

  Longer Stronger Taller
- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant: Hotter Bigger Sadder
  - Two syllables adjectives ending in Y, change Y for I:

Heavy - Heavier Funny - Funnier

 Three or more syllables adjectives, we use more:

Intelligent - More inteligent

We use them to say the biggest grade of a characteristic

- Adjectives of one or two syllables:

  Add the and -est

  The Strongest The tallest
- One syllable adjectives ending with a vowel and a consonant, double the consonant:
   The hottest The biggest The saddest
- Two syllables adjectives ending in Y, change Y for I:

Heavy - The heaviest Funny - The funniest

- Three or more syllables adjectives, we use the most: Intelligent - The most intelligent
