The first amusement park in the world was Bakken in Denmark. It opened in 1583! It had simple rides and also dancing and fireworks. The largest amusement park in the world today is probably Walt Disney World Resort in Florida, USA. It has four theme parks and two water parks. One of these, The Magic Kingdom, is the most popular theme park in the world, with 17 million visitors a year.

Kingda Ka in Six Flags Great Adventure theme park, New Jersey, USA, drops visitors from a height of 139 metres! It can carry up to 1,400 riders per hour and the ride lasts for 28 seconds. It's taller than any other ride in the world.

Formula Rossa at Ferrari World in Abu Dhabi has a roller coaster that travels at 240 km per hour. It is faster than any other roller coaster. People who went on it said that it felt like being in a rocket!
