ORIGINAL CARROT CAKE RECIPE

- 2 cups Self Raising Flour.
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon
- 1 cup vegetable oil
- 2 cups sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 4 eggs
- 4 cups grated carrots

- cup Self Raising Flour.
- teaspoon baking soda
- teaspoon ground cinnamon
- cup vegetable oil
- cup sugar
- teaspoon vanilla extract
- egg
- cup grated carrots
