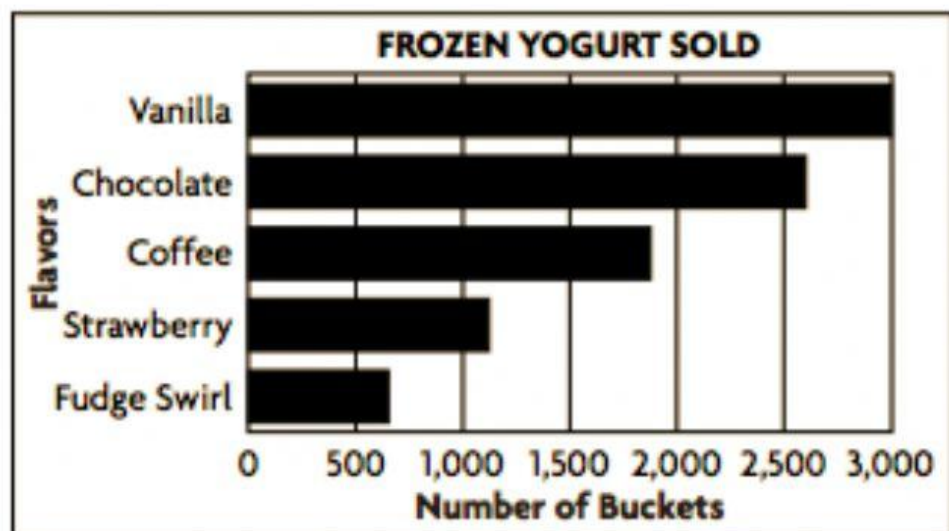
Use a Bar Graph

UNDERSTAND your problem. You own a frozen-yogurt store. You want to have a sale on flavors that sold less than 2,000 buckets last year. Which flavors should you have on sale?

PLAN Use a graph to help solve your problem.

SOLVE The bar graph shows the frozen yogurt you sold last year. How are the numbers related? The numbers for buckets sold are in order from greatest to least. Coffee is the first flavor in the list that is less than 2,000. Since the numbers are listed from greatest to least, the flavors listed after coffee are all less than 2,000.

You should have a sale on coffee, strawberry, and fudge swirl yogurt.

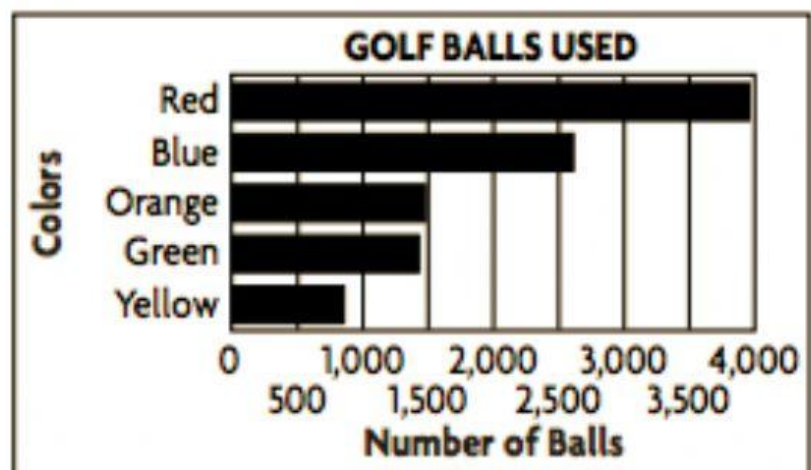


For Problems 1–4, use the bar graph.
