<p>Modal Verbs</p>	<h1>Should</h1>	
<p>Uses of Should:</p>		
<p>Advice or Suggestion</p> <p>- Your hair is too long. You should get a haircut.</p>		<p>SHOULD vs. OUGHT TO</p> <p>Should can be replaced by ought to without a change in meaning.</p> <p>- You ought to study more. =</p> <p>- You should study more.</p> <p>Note: ought to sounds more formal than should and is used less frequently.</p>
<p>Situation likely in the present</p> <p>- Mary should be at home now. Give her a call.</p>		
<p>Likely in the future (prediction)</p> <p>- They should win tonight, they're a better team.</p>		<p>We use SHOULDN'T to advise not to do something, usually because it is bad or wrong.</p> <p>- You shouldn't throw your litter onto the street.</p> <p>- He shouldn't play with those wires if he doesn't know what he is doing.</p> <p>- You shouldn't work so much.</p>
<p>Should + have + past participle</p> <p><i>Meaning: The subject did not fulfill their obligation in the past or did not act responsibly.</i></p> <p>- You should have given your boss the report yesterday when he asked for it.</p>		
<p>Should + be + verb-ing</p> <p><i>Meaning: The subject is not fulfilling their obligation now or is not acting sensibly.</i></p> <p>- You should be wearing your seatbelt.</p> <p>- We should be studying for the test right now.</p>
