

WHAT ARE THEY DOING?

Present Continuous

Es aquel tiempo para describir una acción que está teniendo lugar en este momento.

El "present continuous" se compone de dos partes: el presente del verbo to be + otro verbo terminado en "ing"
Ejemplos:



She is riding a bike.

Pronoun + verb to be + verb (ing) + complement.

Ella está montando una bicicleta.



He is reading a book.

Pronoun + verb to be + verb (ing) + complement.

El está leyendo un libro.



She is flying a kite.

Pronoun + verb to be + verb (ing) + complement.

Ella está volando una cometa.



He is playing with a ball.

Pronoun + verb to be + verb (ing) + complement.

El está jugando con una pelota.

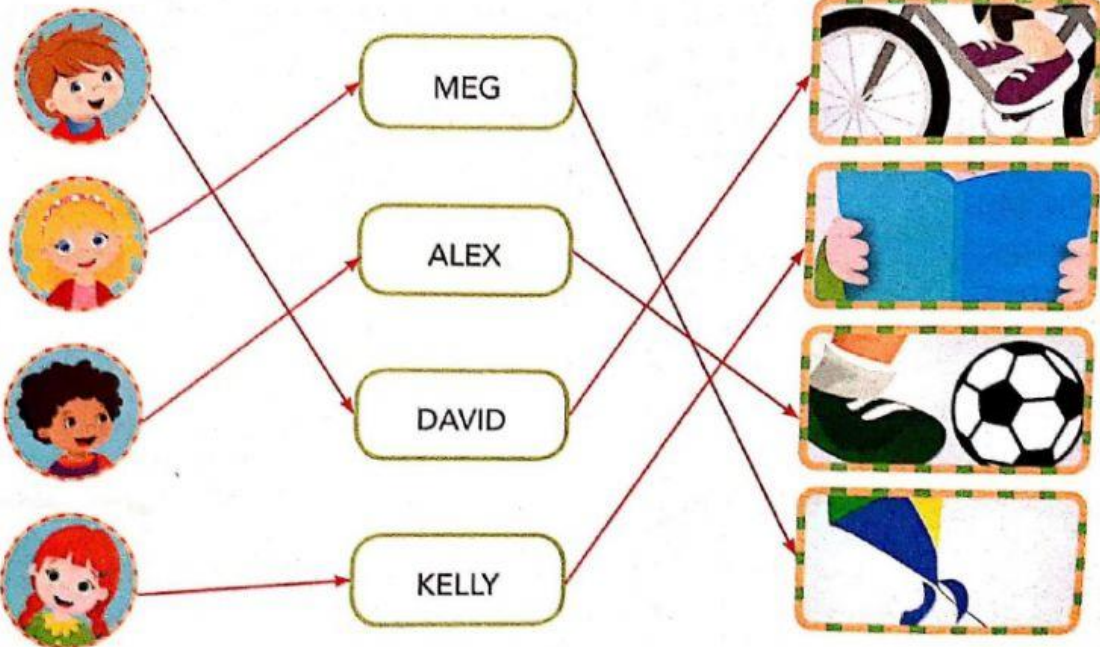
