### Simple past of the verb *be*

#### Affirmative

He **was** in Veracruz.  
They **were** in Mexico.

#### Negative

He **wasn't** in Cancún.  
They **weren't** in the U.S.

#### Questions

**Was** he in Mexico?  
.....  
**Were** they in the U.S.?

#### Short answers

Yes, he **was**./  
No, he **wasn't**.  
Yes, they **were**./  
No, they **weren't**.

- yesterday morning/afternoon/evening
- last night/week/month/year
- last Monday/July





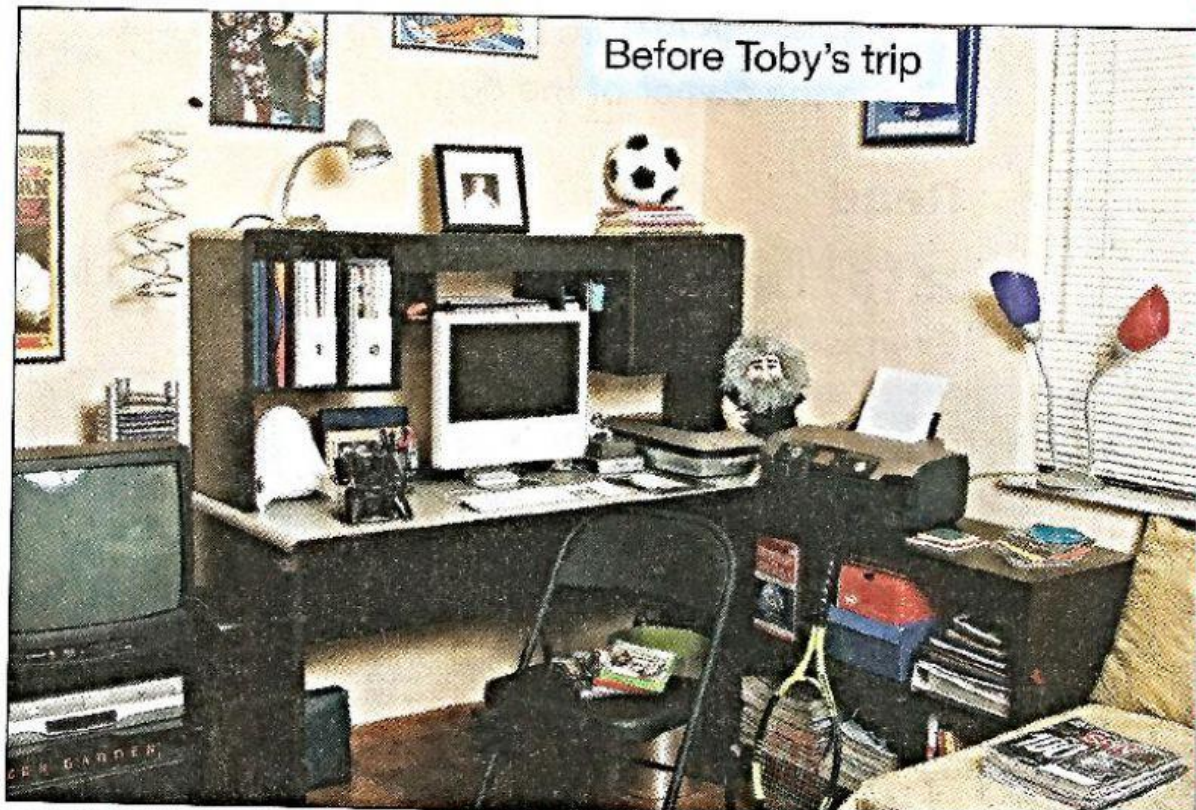
