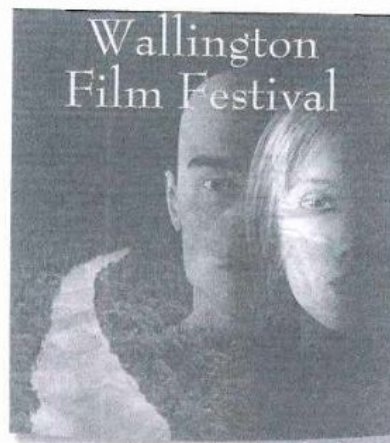
- A: Can you <sup>1</sup> ..... me what we have to do for our project?
