5. I (get) up early this morning, I (brush) my teeth, I (dress) and then I (have) breakfast.
6. The postman (come) while I (have) breakfast.
7. The boys (play) football when they (break) a window.
8. We (meet) Joan at the party. She (wear) a red dress.
9. I was late but my friends (wait) for me when I (arrive).
10. I (get) up at 7 o'clock. The sun (shine), so I (go) for a walk.
11. He (not/drive) fast when the accident (happen).
12. Margaret (not/go) to work yesterday. She was ill.
13. 'What (you/do) on Saturday evening?'
'I went to the cinema.'
14. 'What (you/do) at 9.30 on Saturday evening?'
'I (watch) a film in the cinema.'
