HAY 5 BANANAS EN LA MESA (**THERE ARE** 5 BANANAS ON THE TABLE)

La única diferencia es la siguiente:

THERE IS va seguido de un solo objeto por eso en esta oración "**THERE IS** A BANANA ON THE TABLE" usamos **THERE IS**

THERE ARE va seguido de varios objetos, por eso en esta oración "**THERE ARE** 5 BANANAS ON THE TABLE" usamos **THERE ARE**

THERE IS A LEMON ON THE FRIDGE

THERE IS MILK ON THE FRIDGE

THERE IS CHICKEN ON THE FRIDGE

(EN TODOS LOS CASOS, SOLO HAY UN OBJETO. UN LIMON, LECHE, POLLO)

THERE ARE 5 ORANGES ON THE FRIDGE

THERE ARE 3 BANANAS ON THE FRIDGE

THERE ARE 2 TOMATOES ON THE FRIDGE

(EN TODOS LOS CASOS, SOLO HAY MAS DE UN OBJETO. 5 NARANJAS, 3 BANANAS, 2 TOMATES)
