

## NOT ENOUGH • TOO MUCH • TOO MANY

### 1. LOOK AT THE CHART.

► TOO MUCH – TOO MANY (more than sufficient)		
Too much	uncountable nouns	There is <b>too much</b> water.
Too many	countable nouns	There are <b>too many</b> chillies.

9. ENOUGH – NOT ENOUGH (sufficient - not sufficient)		
Enough	sufficient	There is <b>enough</b> water. 
Not enough	not sufficient	There <b>isn't</b> enough water.
