




NOT ENOUGH - TOO MUCH - TOO MANY

1. LOOK AT THE CHART.

🐟 TOO MUCH – TOO MANY (more than sufficient)			
Too much	uncountable nouns	There is too much water.	
Too many	countable nouns	There are too many chillies.	

🐟 ENOUGH – NOT ENOUGH (sufficient - not sufficient)			
Enough	sufficient	There is enough water.	
Not enough	not sufficient	There isn't enough water.
