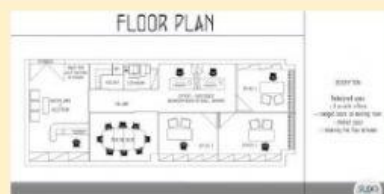


FLOOR PLAN

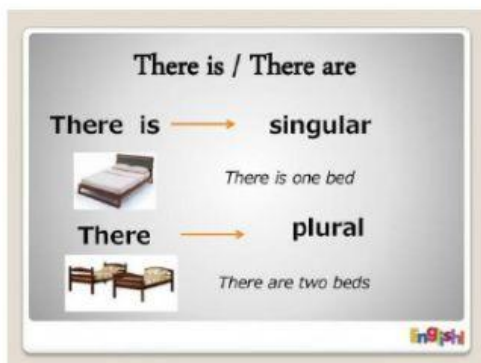
A floor plan is a drawing to scale. It shows a view from above and you can see relationships between rooms, spaces, and other physical features at one level of a structure.

You can draw dimensions between the walls to specify room sizes and wall lengths. In Floor plans **there are** details of fixtures like sinks, water heaters, furnaces, furniture, etc.

For example, in the floor plan on the left, **there are** three private offices. **There is** a waiting area and reception.
