A brick (1) **IS** / **ARE** a building material. People (2) **USES** / **USE** it to make walls, pavements and other elements in masonry construction. The term brick (3) **ARE** / **IS** used to denote rectangular units made of clay-bearing soil, sand, and lime, or concrete materials. People around the world (4) **PRODUCE** / **PRODUCES** bricks in numerous classes, types, materials, and sizes which vary with regions and time period. Two basic categories of bricks (5) **ARE** / **IS** fired and non-fired bricks. Block (6) **REFER** / **REFERS** to a rectangular building unit composed of similar materials, but is usually larger than a brick. Fired bricks (7) **IS** / **ARE** one of the longest-lasting and strongest building materials. Another type of brick is air-dried brick, some people (8) **CALLS** / **CALL** it also mudbricks. They (8) **HAS** / **HAVE** a history older than fired brick. Each mudbricks (9) **HAVE** / **HAS** an additional ingredient of a mechanical binder such as straw. Bricks are an important material in construction. Builders (10) **NEED** / **NEEDS** to know about this material.
