**A. Past Simple: Irregular Verbs**

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I/You/We/They He/She/It <b>slept.</b>	I/You/We/They He/She/It <b>didn't sleep.</b>	Did I/You/We/They he/she/it <b>sleep?</b>

• Common irregular verbs:

begin - began	break - broke	buy - bought	come - came	do - did
drink - drank	drive - drove	eat - ate	find - found	give - gave
go - went	have - had	make - made	meet - met	read - read
see - saw	sleep - slept	speak - spoke	take - took	write - wrote

**B. Past Simple: Be**

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I/He/She/It <b>was</b> ... You/We/They <b>were</b> ...	I/He/She/It <b>wasn't</b> ... You/We/They <b>weren't</b> ...	<b>Was</b> I/he/she/it...? <b>Were</b> you/we/they...?

- There are two forms of the past tense for Be: **was** and **were**
- **Was** is the past tense of **am** and **is**. **Were** is the past tense of **are**.
- **wasn't** = was + not    **weren't** = were + not
