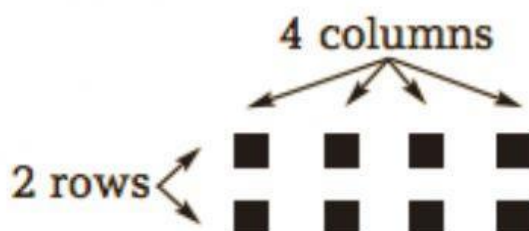


An **array** shows objects in rows and columns.

You can use an array to help you **count** the total number in 2 rows of 4.



Count. There are a total of 8 tiles. So, 2 rows of 4 equals 8.

You can use an array to help you **multiply** the total number in 2 rows of 4.

Since 2 rows of 4 = 8, you know that $2 \times 4 = 8$.
