LEARN THIS! Singular and plural forms



- a** To make the plural of most nouns we add -s.
brother → brothers
- b** If the noun ends in -s, -sh, -ch, -z, or -x, we add -es.
bus → buses class → classes dish → dishes
church → churches watch → watches box → boxes
- c** If the noun ends in -o, we add -s or sometimes -es.
photo → photos potato → potatoes
- d** If the noun ends in a consonant + -y, we change -y to -ies.
party → parties
- e** If the noun ends in a vowel + -y, we add -s.
holiday → holidays
- f** If the noun ends in -f or -fe, we change -f or -fe to -ves.
shelf → shelves
- g** Some nouns have irregular plural forms.
foot → feet man → men woman → women
