## IN THE PAST (YESTERDAY)

We use: **Was**+ a time marker **yesterday**

Question:

How **was** the weather, **yesterday**?

What **was** the weather like **yesterday**?

Response:

It **was** raining/rainy, **yesterday**.

**Yesterday, was** sunny.

It **was** a nice day **yesterday**, it **was** sunny.

## IN THE PRESENT (NOW)

We use: **Is** (we can add a time marker **today** but it is not need)

Question:

How's the weather?

What's the weather like?

What's the weather like **today**?

Response:

It **is** stormy/storming (**today**).

It's cloudy (**today**).

## IN THE FUTURE (TOMORROW)

We use: **Will be** or **Going to be** + a time marker **Tomorrow**

Question:

What's the weather **going to be** like **tomorrow**?

What **will** the weather **be** like **tomorrow**?


Response:

It **will be** partly cloudy **tomorrow**.

It's **going to be** foggy **tomorrow**.

**Tomorrow will be** sunny and nice!
