COMPARATIVE AND SUPERLATIVE FORM OF ADJECTIVES

comparison between two things (comparatives) or when a group of things is being compared and there's the need to mention the items within the group that are in the extremes (superlatives).

noun (as a subject) + verb + comparative adjective + than + noun (as an object). EXAMPLE: Panama is smaller than Spain.

Cars move faster than bicycles.

On the other hand, when using superlatives in a sentence, the structure

to be used is this one: noun (as a subject) + verb + the + superlative

adjective + noun (as an object)
