STORY: PAST SIMPLE AND PAST CONTINUOUS

We often use the *PAST SIMPLE* and the *PAST CONTINUOUS* in stories. They are usually combined with the words *when* or *while*. The *Past Continuous* is the action in progress that is interrupted by the main action in the *Simple Past*. The *Simple Past* shows an action or an event that happened in the middle of the longer action expressed by the *Past Continuous*.

Activity: complete the story using Past Simple or Past Continuous.

Mark is usually late for school on Mondays. Last Monday, he
(1) (get up) at 7:10 and his class started at 7:30! He
(2) (watch) TV while he
(3)(have) breakfast and suddenly he
(4)(notice) that it was really very late.
He (5) (get ready) for school when his phone
(6) (ring). It (7)(be) his best friend telling him not to
forget his football boots for the match after lunch. Outside the house, his mum
(8)(wait) for him in their car. When he
(9)(get) into the car, he (10)(notice)
that she (11)(be) very angry.
Finally, he (12) (arrive) at school at 7.30
and he (13)(run) to his classroom. When his classmates
(14) (see) him, they (15)
(start) to laugh. At that moment he realized he (16)(wear) his
slippers. That (17) (be) really embarrassing!
