A) A or is a kind of website which combines text, images and links related to a particular topic. Postings appear in chronological order with the most recent ones coming first. You don't need to be an expert to update and maintain it.

B) A is an image of a computer keyboard that is projected using light onto any surface. You can use it with your PC, laptop, or with a compatible mobile phone. When you are not using it, it disappears.

C) is a type of program that monitors what users do on the Internet without their knowledge and transmits that information to someone else. It can collect information for advertising purposes, or try to intercept passwords or credit card numbers.



D) A is a thin, flat device to display images. It consists of colour or monochrome pixels spread out in front of a reflector, and it consumes very small amounts of electric power. It is used in many electronic, for example, digital watches, CD players, laptop computers, PC screens and so on.

E) A is a type of software that you can use to create, remove or edit content on a web page. Anyone can freely contribute with information without having any specific technical knowledge.

F) A or, among other names, is a device used for storing data. It consists of a small printed circuit board with a plastic or metal case, and it can be connected directly to a USB port on a PC.

G) A replaces the typical keyboard/mouse combination. It is ideal for people who have wrist or finger injuries, RSI (Repetitive Strain Injury) or limited fine motor skills. You can use it for computing or accessing the Internet.
