**Subject  
pronouns**

**Always followed by the noun it  
is describing**  
my, your, his, her, its, our, their

**Object  
pronouns**

**Replaces the noun. Is NOT  
followed by a noun**  
mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs

**Possessive  
adjectives**

**takes the place of a noun as the  
subject of a sentence.**  
I, you, he, she, it, we, they

**Possessive  
pronouns**

**used when subject & object of  
sentence are the same**  
myself, yourself, himself, herself,  
itself, ourselves, themselves

**Reflexive  
pronouns**

**used as the direct/indirect  
object of a verb, or preposition.**  
me, you, him, her, it, us, them
