

## PASSIVE VOICE- PRESENT SIMPLE & PAST SIMPLE

**Form:** Be + Past Participle

Present Simple: am/is/are + Past Participle

Past Simple: was/were + Past Participle

**Use:** 1) We don't know who the doer is.  
2) It is not important who it is.
