#### How to prepare jelly

Buy a box of jelly powder, choose the flavour you prefer.

Peel an apple and slice it. Arrange \_\_\_\_\_ slices of apple at the bottom of different small bowls.

Put the jelly powder in a big bowl. \_\_\_\_\_  $\frac{1}{2}$  litre of boiling water in the bowl and \_\_\_\_\_ to dissolve the powder. Add  $\frac{1}{2}$  litre of cold water and stir for some minutes. Pour \_\_\_\_\_ mixture in the different small bowls with the apple slices and take them to the fridge for a couple of hours.

Serve the jelly when it is ready. You can add \_\_\_\_\_ cream on top if you want.
