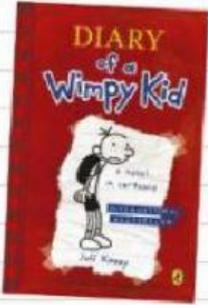
## Diary of a Wimpy Kid
