Orcas are called **killer whales** too. But they aren't whales – they're part of the dolphin family. We usually see orcas in family groups, called pods. A good time to see orcas is from June to September. They're black and white.

Sea otters live in groups. Sometimes there are 100 otters in one group. They're brown or black. Sea otters love swimming and they often swim on their backs.



Puffins usually live on the sea. They've got black, white and grey bodies. Their beaks are black and orange. In May, they come to the coast and make their nests. They have one chick. You can see them flying to their nests with lots of fish in their beaks.
