## LUIS

This is Luis. He's Mexican, and he lives on the central Pacific Coast. He is an 'ostionero', or an oyster diver. He has been an oyster diver for the last ten years. Most of his family are oyster divers too. He usually dives with his brother, Jesus. He sometimes dives with one of his uncles and some of his cousins.

Luis goes diving five days a week, from Monday to Friday. Sometimes he goes on Saturdays too, but he never dives on Sundays. That's his day off and he always spends it with his family.

Luis always dives in the morning, although he doesn't get up early. He usually starts at about 8 am and works for two or three hours. In his hometown, there are about ten places that are good for diving. His favorite is called Playa Blanca, and he dives there about twice a week. He takes an inner tube with him. It has a net inside, and he uses it to collect the oysters.

When Luis and his brother get back to the beach, they give the oysters to Luis's wife. She opens a temporary 'restaurant' on the beach. It's very simple, with just a sunshade, one table, and four chairs. Customers come every day to eat the fresh oysters with lime.

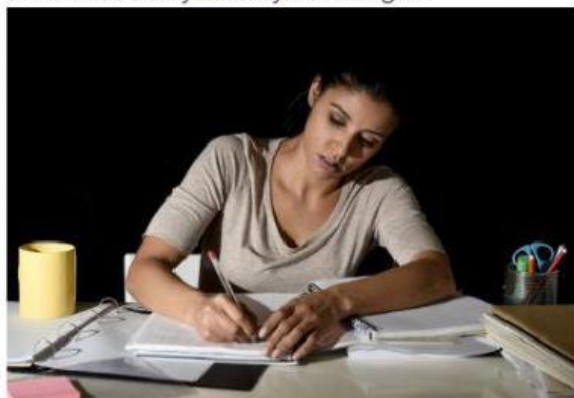
