

Simple Past Verb to be: Wh/ Yes-No Questions

Look at the chart and the order for questions:

Question words + was / were

When	were you	*born?
Why	was he	at home?
Where	was she	on Sunday?
How old	were you	in 2004?

Now read these examples:

Yes/ No questions:

a. **Was** your uncle at home yesterday?

Yes, he **was** / No, he **wasn't**

b. **Were** your brothers at school last month?

Yes, they **were** / No, they **weren't**

c. **Were you** in Brazil last year?

Yes, **I was** / No, **I wasn't**

He was in Córdoba last week

2. **Where** were you yesterday?

I was in Cafayate

3. **Why** was your cousin in Buenos Aires?

Because she was studying.
