A + CONSONANT -> I WANT **A** PEAR
AN + VOWEL -> I WANT **AN** EGG

I WANT **SOME** MUSHROOMS

SOME + UNCOUNTABLE

I WANT **SOME** MILK
I WANT **SOME** ORANGE JUICE
