A/AN + COUNTABLE SINGULAR

A + CONSONANT -> I WANT **A** PEAR  
AN + VOWEL -> I WANT **AN** EGG

SOME + COUNTABLE PLURAL

I WANT **SOME** TOMATOES  
I WANT **SOME** MUSHROOMS

SOME + UNCOUNTABLE

I WANT **SOME** MILK  
I WANT **SOME** ORANGE JUICE
