An ordinal number indicates position or order (e.g., first, second, third). This could include placement in a race or competition, or it could simply be the day of the month (e.g., December 1st).

Ordinal Numbers

Ordinal number; a number defining the position of something in a series, such as 'first', 'second', or 'third'. Ordinal numbers are used as adjectives, nouns, and pronouns.
