*if a word ends with the letter y, then remove y and add ier

Eg. nasty → nasty ~~y~~ + ier → nastier

** we sometimes double the last letter of the word when adding -er or -est

big ⇒ bigger ⇒ biggest,

fat ⇒ fatter ⇒ fattest,

thin ⇒ thinner ⇒ thinnest
