




➤ DOMINGO FAUSTINO SARMIENTO WAS BORN ON FEBRUARY 15, 1811 IN SAN JUAN.



➤ AT THE AGE OF 15 HE WAS ALREADY A TEACHER AND HE FOUNDED HIS FIRST SCHOOL IN SAN LUIS.



➤ HE HAD MANY JOBS, BUT THE MOST IMPORTANT WAS THAT HE BECAME PRESIDENT OF ARGENTINA.



➤ AS PRESIDENT HE WAS VERY COMMITTED TO EDUCATION.



➤ HE DIED ON SEPTEMBER 11, 1888. TODAY HE IS REMEMBERED AS THE FATHER OF SCHOOL.
