

Disneyland Paris



Disneyland is a spectacular place, with its magical castle and fantastic parades. You can see all the popular film characters; even adults enjoy taking a selfie with their childhood favourites! With all the crazy developments that have happened in 2020, how can people visit safely and still have fun?

To visit Disneyland, first you have to choose a method of **travel**. The easiest option is to **fly on a plane**. An **airport** can be the start of an adventure, but there are some new rules in place to protect people from Coronavirus. The most important things to remember are you have to wear a **mask** and **disinfect your hands** frequently.

The first thing to do at the airport is **check-in**. Usually, you go to a **check-in desk** and an employee checks your ticket is correct. Now, you have to use an app on your phone or tablet. This way, people do not have to queue or stay too close together in the communal areas.

Security is where people often have to wait a long time. Security guards must check every individual has the correct papers and look inside their **hand luggage**. If you travel today, you may also have to answer some **questions about your health** and someone will **take your temperature**. This is to try and make sure you do not carry the virus to another country.





There is no need to worry though. You can still go to **departures** and look around the shops, just try not to touch too many things! You have to keep your hand luggage on a **trolley** and wait in the departure lounge until they call you. Be careful walking to the **runway** because many people will be moving at the same time. You should **keep your distance** at all times!

When you **board** the plane, your ticket gets checked again and **flight attendants** welcome you to the plane. During the flight, you must keep your mask on. The only time you can remove it is when you are eating. During **take-off**, as the plane flies up, you have to wear your seatbelt. You should try to keep it on as much as possible, but you must wear it when the plane prepares **to land**, too.



Before you go, you need to **book your tickets** for Disneyland and pay online, you can't just go. Then, when you arrive you do not have to **queue** and wait. You will have to answer more questions about how you feel and your **general health** before you enter the **attraction park**.

When you are there, you will see people cleaning all the time. It is a safety precaution, and you can help them by **wearing your mask** and cleaning your hands at the **sanitizing stations** regularly. It's possible you might have to wait a little longer to use **transport** like the **train** or **bus** in the park because they mustn't be 'full capacity', but this is to help with **social distancing** and prevent you **catching the virus** while you are having fun!
