



The giraffe family

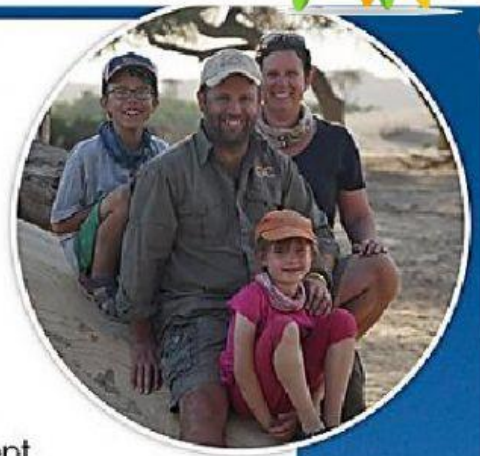
