1. Han has 5 comic books. He gives 3 comic books to his friend. How many comic books does Han have now?



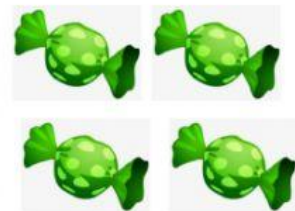
