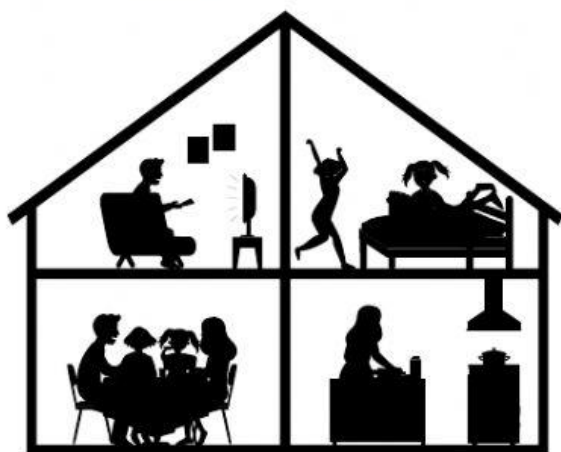
MUNA'S HOUSE²

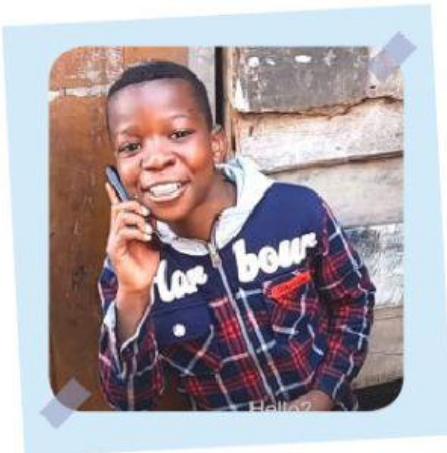
I love my family and my home but I miss my school friends. Sometimes we speak on the phone.

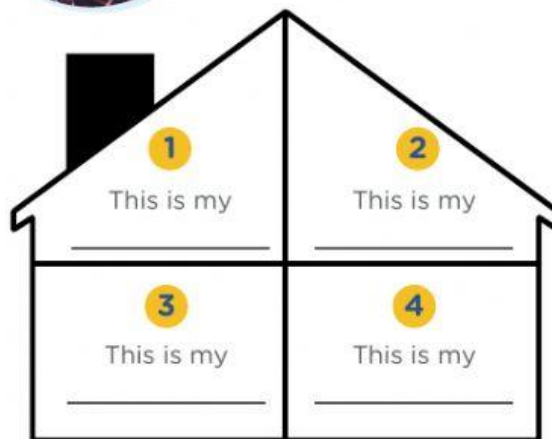
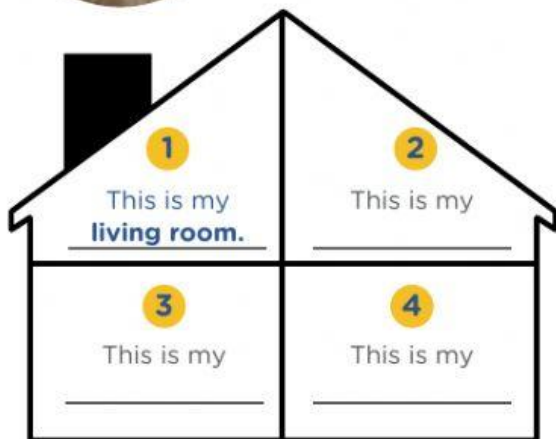
