


## This is a true story.

SPELLING RULES

Past simple of regular verbs: affirmative and negative	
<b>Affirmative</b>	They <b>noticed</b> a strange animal. A police car <b>arrived</b> . The players <b>stopped</b> their games.
<b>Negative</b>	They <b>didn't notice</b> a strange animal. A police car <b>didn't arrive</b> . The players <b>didn't stop</b> their games.

use - used

vowel + y...  
+ed**

play - played  
enjoy - enjoyed

**Verbs ending:  
consonant + y...  
+ied**
