Abigail: Um ... Let me think ... I saw a three, a five and I think I saw an eight. But I definitely saw a three and a five.

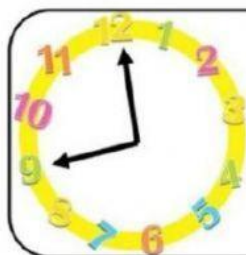

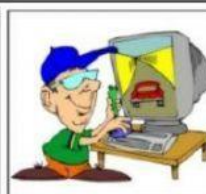

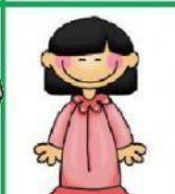
