

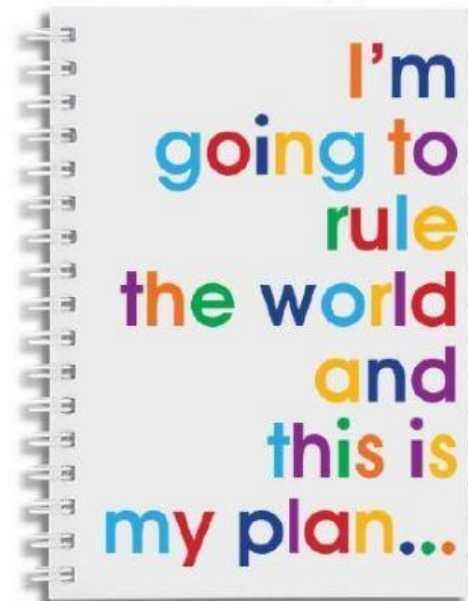
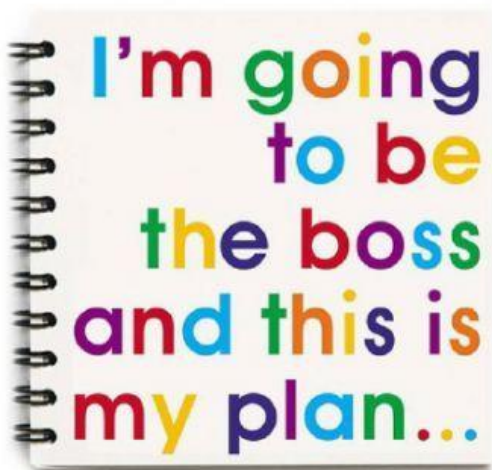

1) GOING TO

Future plans and intentions Dreams and predictions



You express **INTENTIONS**, you have already decided to do something. More examples:

- Are you going to buy a new car or a second-hand car?
- I am going to visit my Grandmother this month. I miss her.
- She is going to be an excellent professor.

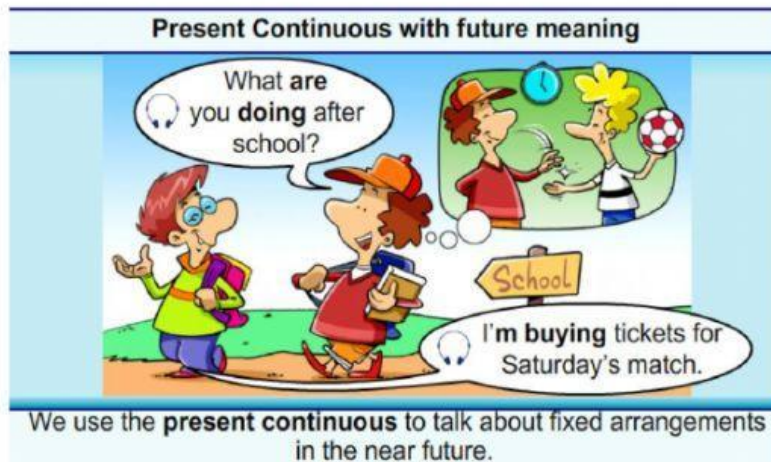
Predictions about the future, especially when you can see or have some evidence.



Look at those black clouds. I think it is going to rain.



I will brush my teeth every day to keep them clean and healthy!
(This is his promise.)

I am the best detective in the city! I will catch the robber for you.
(He promises to catch the criminal.)
